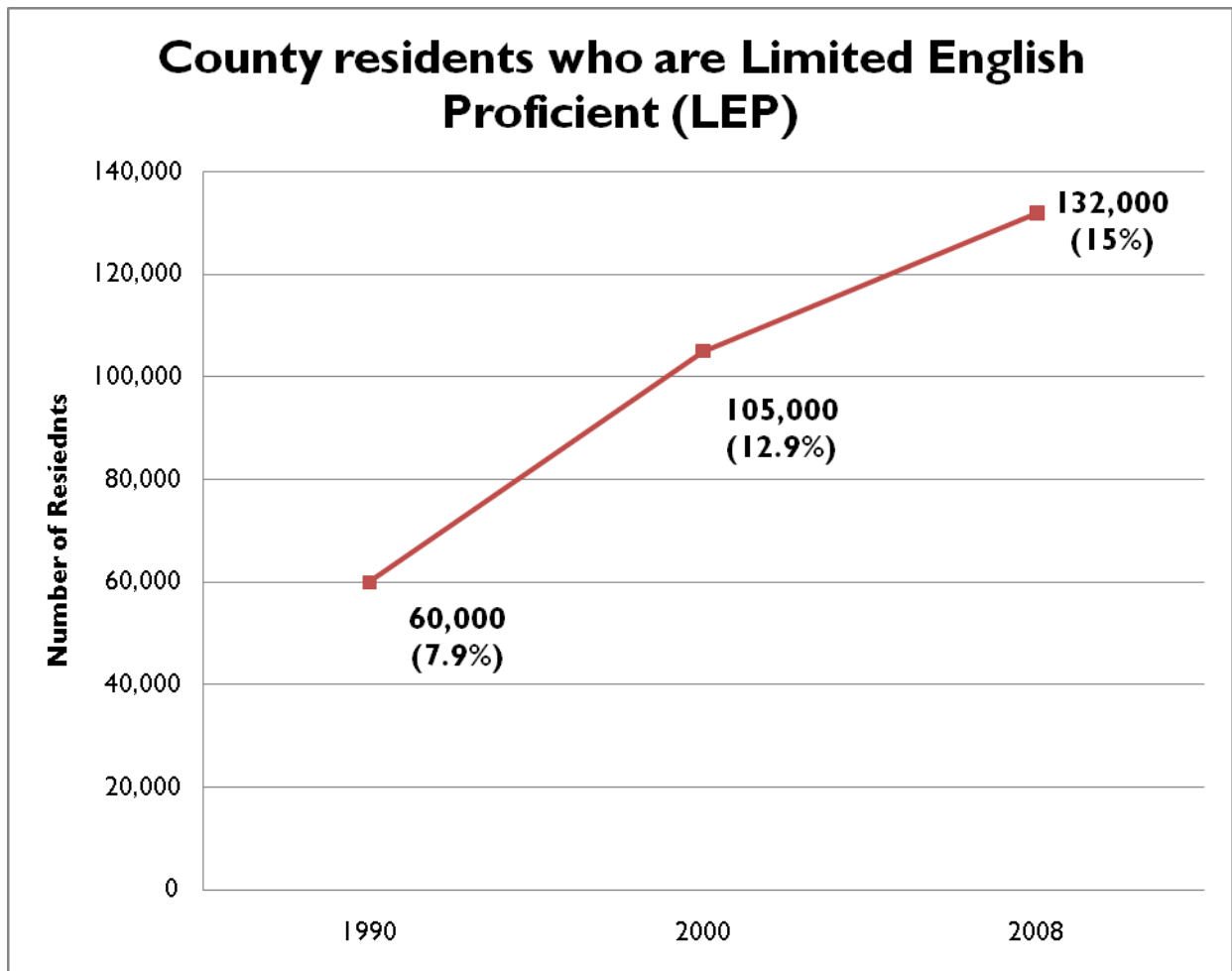

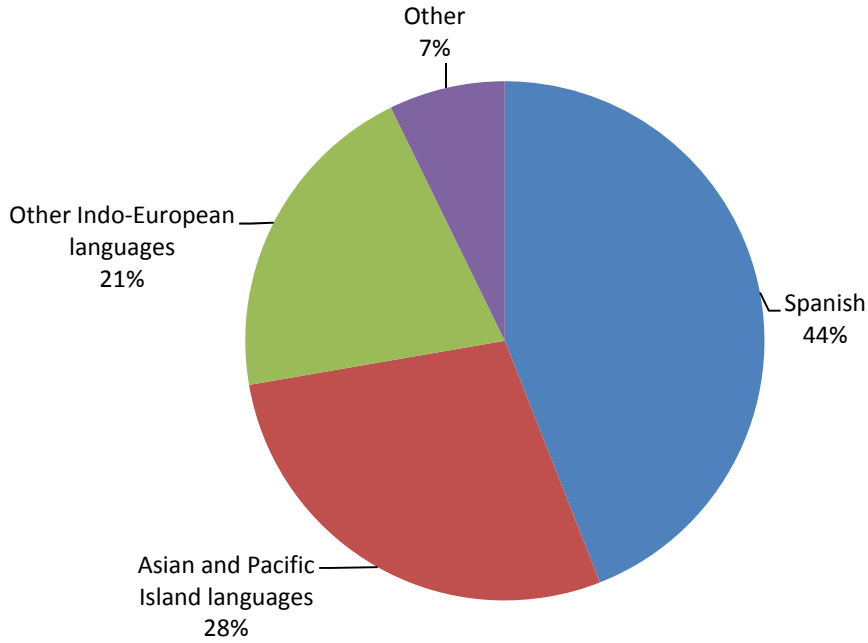

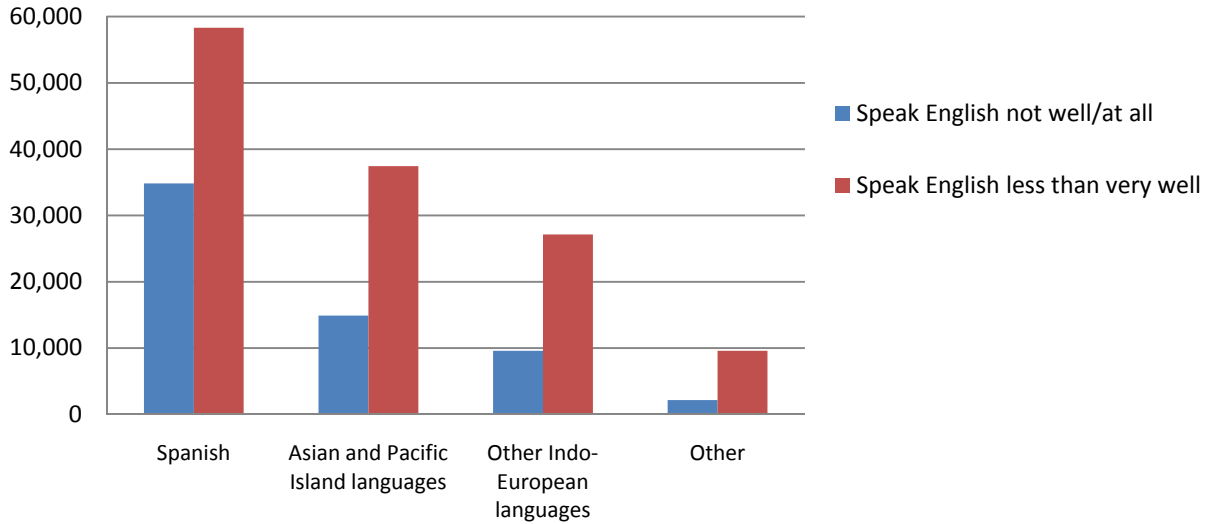

Percentage of County Population Who Speak English "Less than Very Well" by Language

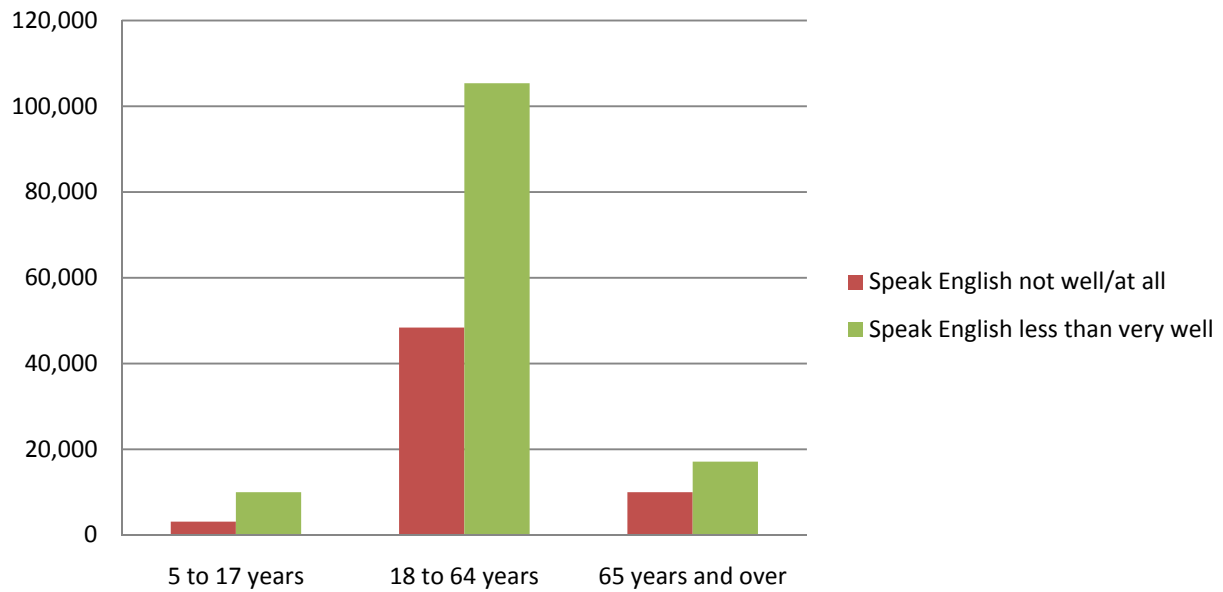


Montgomery County LEP Residents by Language

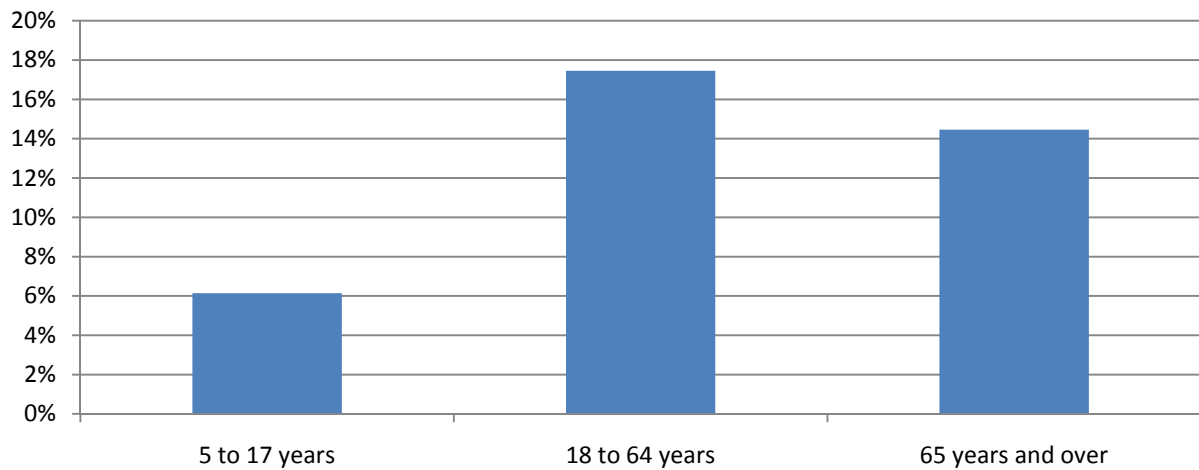

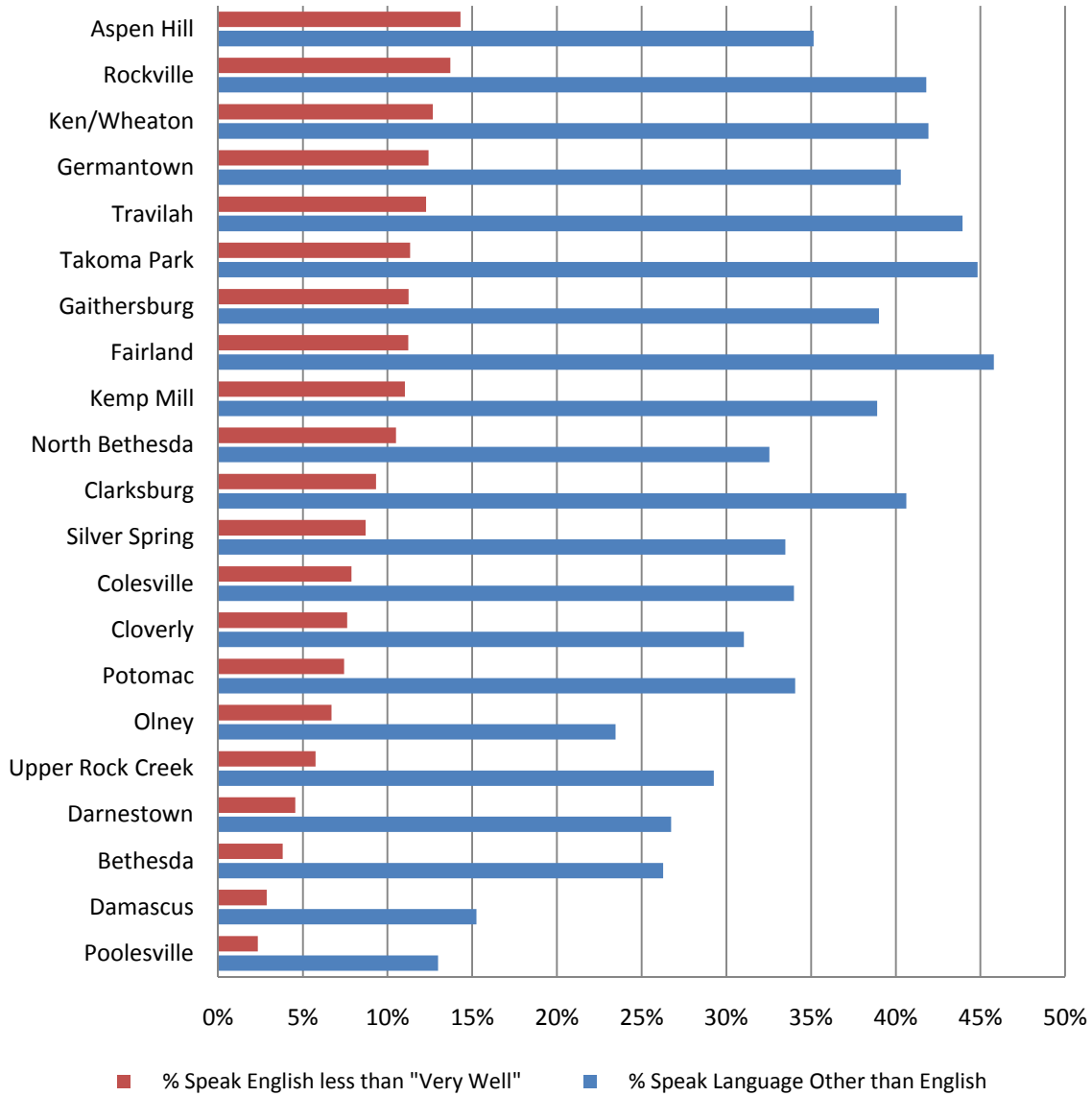
